— Now is the Time for Action on HPV —


The Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine has been used in the United States and around the world for six years and is very safe. The HPV vaccine prevents cervical, oropharynx and other cancers in women and men.

Florida has the worst HPV vaccination rate in the country.

Florida's estimated rate of female adolescents aged 13-17 who receive all three doses of the HPV vaccination is only 25.3%, compared to the national average rate of 33.4%

It's not surprising that Florida has one of the highest rates of cervical cancer.

Florida's cervical cancer rate is 9.0 per 100,000 women. Hillsborough County's rate is even worse at 9.4, and Pinellas County's rate is 7.6
