What if he hadn't broken our promise? What if we keep global warming below 2 degrees?

In just Florida alone,
over the next 50 years we could prevent approximately:



101,000 premature deaths



40,000 emergency room visits and hospitalizations for cardiovascular and respiratory disease



More than 23 million lost workdays



The economic value of these health benefits would exceed
\$750 billion in Florida.
