**Ban on semi-automatic assault rifles.**

- HR 3947 Automatic Gun Fire Prevention Act: Makes it a crime to sell, import, manufacture, transfer, or possess a trigger crank, bump-fire device, or any part or accessory that is designed to accelerate the rate of fire of a semiautomatic rifle.

**Ban on high-capacity magazines.**

- HR 5087 Restore the Assault Weapons Ban: Makes it a crime to import, sell, manufacture, transfer, or possess a semiautomatic assault weapon (with exemptions)
- HR 4052 Keep Americans Safe Act: Makes it a crime to knowingly transfer, possess, import, or bring into the US a large capacity ammunition feeding device (with exemptions)

### **Universal comprehensive background checks**

- H.R.2841 Disarm Hate Act: This bill prohibits firearm sale or transfer to and receipt or possession by an individual who has: (1) been convicted in any court of a misdemeanor hate crime, or (2) received from any court an enhanced hate crime misdemeanor sentence.
- HR 5383 Ammunition Background Check Act: Prevents the purchase of ammunition by prohibited purchasers
- HR 4240: Ensures that all individuals who should be prohibited from buying a firearm are listed in the National Instant Criminal Background Check System and provide a responsible and consistent background check process.
- HR 3464 Background Check Completion Act: Prohibits a licensed gun dealer from transferring a firearm to an unlicensed person prior to the completion of a background check.

### **Funds for the CDC (Center for Disease Control) to research the gun violence epidemic in America**

- HR 1832: authorizing FY18 – FY23 appropriations for the Centers for Diseases Control and Prevention to conduct or support research on firearms safety or gun violence prevention.
- H.R. 1478 Gun Violence Research Act: Prevents HHS from blocking federal funds going towards advocating and promoting gun safety

### **In addition, U.S. Rep. Kathy Castor (FL14) is cosponsor of the following legislation:**

- H.Res. 367 Establish Select Committee on Gun Violence
- H.Res.370 Moments of Silence are Not Enough Act: Whenever a moment of silence related to a tragedy in the United States or its territories involving gun violence occurs on the floor of the House, to announce on the next legislative day the standing committee (or subcommittee) designated to hold a hearing on the event.
