RE: Veterans Administration Backlog Critical at St. Petersburg VA Regional Office – Request Plan of Action and Timeline

Dear Secretary Shinseki:

Thank you for your leadership and service to our nation's veterans. I respectfully request that you address the egregious backlog of veteran disability claims at the St. Petersburg VA Regional Office. I understand that you are tackling the backlog on a national basis, but the untenable backlog at the St. Petersburg VA Regional Office requires immediate attention.

The St. Petersburg, VA Regional office backlog has the second highest number of outstanding claims in the country. As of November 24th there were 46,929 pending claims in the St. Petersburg VA Regional Office. The processing time also is longer than the national average. This is unacceptable. The backlog is delaying benefits that veterans earned. Such long waiting times are a disservice to veterans and their families.

I respectfully request an immediate plan of action to reduce the St. Petersburg VA backlog and a briefing on the goals and the timeline that the Department of Veterans Affairs has chosen to approach the task of resolving the matter.

I will continue to work for our veterans and coordinate with the local VA office, but that is not enough. We need action now to eliminate the backlog. Thank you in advance for your
